What is a cookie?

A cookie is a chunk of data – typically stored as a text file – that is placed on your computer or other devices when you visit a particular website.

The cookie is used to identify your device to the website when you visit again so the site can load your preferences, automatically accept your credentials, or otherwise personalize the experience.

Accepting cookies

Within your browser settings, you can choose whether to accept cookies. To access https://www.sunsetbayassociation.com, you are encouraged to enable cookies (which most browsers do by default). That way, we can remember you and tailor your experience to better suit your needs.

If you are using Safari as your browser, you should also enable cross-site tracking by disabling the Prevent Cross-Site Tracking option.

Third-party cookies

You can also separately control whether to accept third-party cookies – cookies placed by third party services that are integrated into the website you are visiting.

For example, third-party cookies are used by Google Analytics for tracking website traffic. You only need to enable third-party cookies only if you are using third-party services that require you to do so.

By default, Safari and Internet Explorer block third-party cookies, while Firefox and Chrome accept them. However, Safari and Internet Explorer will allow users to accept cookies from WildApricot, and other sites. Some firewalls or browser plug-ins may affect your browser's cookies settings.
